DENVER – Hear Us Now! is delighted to announce our decision to endorse Mr. Ken Buck, Weld County's District Attorney, to become the next United States Senator for the great State of Colorado.

In making its endorsement, Hear Us Now! considered Mr. Buck's commitment to upholding the United States Constitution, principles of limited government, and – to preserve our God given rights – the only legitimate purpose for the existence of Government. Mr. Buck recognizes the life of our Republic is at stake, and he is willing to take his campaign all the way through November 2, 2010.

In addition, Hear Us Now! appreciates Mr. Buck's expressed commitment to protect the sanctity of life at all phases, stop spending, cut taxes, and reduce or remove restrictive regulations on businesses. Furthermore, he expressed his strategic ideas to bring these goals to fruition.

Since Mr. Buck announced his senatorial candidacy, members of Hear Us Now! watched and examined him to discover his character. He embraces and recognizes his need for the support of Tea Party and 9-12 groups throughout Colorado. He provided straightforward answers to our many, probing questions and gave us constitutionally based responses.

For example, we asked, if elected, how Mr. Buck would use the office to restore constitutional government to our land. In summary, he replied that proposed legislation must pass the constitutionality test first. Proposed bills must fall under Congress' limited powers, have adequate funding sources identified (other than just taxes), and be available to the public (72-hour advance notice) for evaluation. He would support the appointment of federal judges who strictly follow the intent of the Constitution, and he would block appointments of activist judges.

Hear Us Now! is the official organizer of this year's April 15th Tax Day Tea Party on the west-facing steps of the Colorado State Capital Building. Hear Us Now! extends our invitation to Mr. Buck to appear at this gathering of Colorado citizens seeking future, Legislative Leadership who will fight for Coloradoans.
